

Requirements, Rights and Guidelines of Stewards in Good Standing

Requirements

Any person 18 years of age or older who was baptized in the Orthodox Church and has met his/her stewardship financial obligations to the Parish, is referred to as a **Steward** or a **Parishioner in Good Standing**.

Any person 18 years or older participating in a ministry is required to be a Parishioner in Good Standing. We recommend that parents of children under 18 years of age who participate in youth programs, become Parishioners in Good Standing.

Guidelines

To be a Parishioner in Good Standing, the minimum annual financial obligation to the Parish is \$650.00 (\$1.78 a day/\$12.50 a week). The contribution guideline recommended by the Church and used in parishes across the country is 2-10% of one's income.

Parishioners, who are experiencing financial hardships and are unable to fulfill their stewardship obligations, but still want to participate in the rights above, are encouraged to contact one of our priests.

Rights

Parishioners in Good Standing are welcome to join the Parish Ministries, attend all Parish Assemblies, participate in their discussions and vote therein, and be nominated for election to the Parish Council Board of Directors.

Parishioners in Good Standing participate in Sacraments without paying additional fees and receive reduced tuition at the Hellenic Academy.
