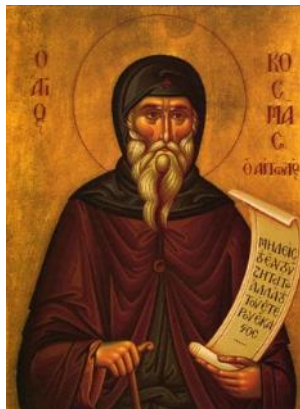


## VIGIL SERVICE

### Join us for a Vigil Service for the Feast of Saint Kosmas Aitolos

A Vigil for the Feast of St. Kosmas Aitolos, New Hieromartyr and Equal-to-the-Apostles will take place in the Sts Constantine and Helen Chapel beginning at 7pm on Monday, August 23rd. The service consists of festal Vespers, a reading from the life of the saint, Orthros with anointing of vigil lamp oil, and concludes with Divine Liturgy with decorative kollyva for the saint.

Keeping vigil (prayerful and attentive watch) is a practice honored by our Lord throughout Scripture (Exodus 12:42; Matthew 26:36-45). It is a practice honored in many Orthodox communities for particular feast days, and certainly experienced in some form universally on Great and Holy Pascha. This vigil allows us an opportunity to engage with the services of the Church as a spiritual exercise, sustained by prayer and support of fellow faithful Orthodox Christians and the bountiful gifts of our Lord.
